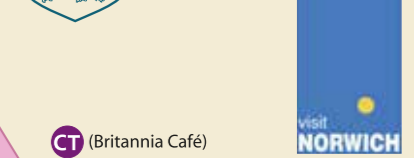
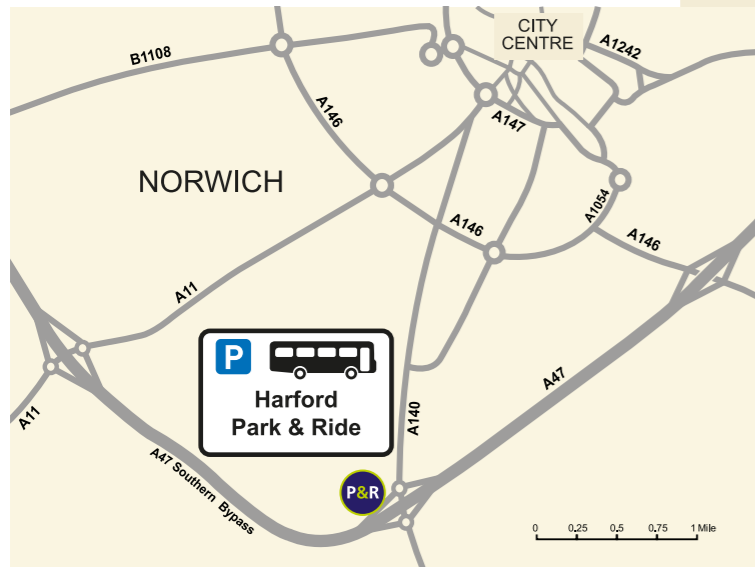

3 spaces. Up to 4 hours, (FREE) (8am - 6.30pm Monday to Saturday only; no restriction at other times)

Rouen Road, NR1 1QP
3 spaces. Up to 4 hours, (FREE) (8am - 6.30pm Monday to Saturday only; no restriction at other times)

Lower Clarence Road, NR1 1HA

Pay by telephone
Booking line 01362 851210 - lines open Monday to Saturday 8.00am to 5.00pm. Debit/credit card payments accepted.

Pay in person (£1 booking fee applies) at Norwich Tourist Information in the Forum, open Monday to Saturday 9.30am to 5.30pm all year and Sundays 10.30am to 3.30pm. (mid July to mid September). Arrive by coach (Theatre Street set down point) and walk 1 minute to the Norwich Tourist Information Centre. Cash or debit/credit cards accepted.

All coaches for NCFC coach stop may enter and depart via Canary Way/Carrow Road. Alternative exit via **BUS GATE** at Geoffrey Watling Way/Koblenz Avenue normally allows coaches to proceed ahead (to Wherry Road) or right (Koblenz Avenue); on Matchdays under traffic management control coaches may also proceed left (towards river) when bollards are lowered to allow this manoeuvre.
